



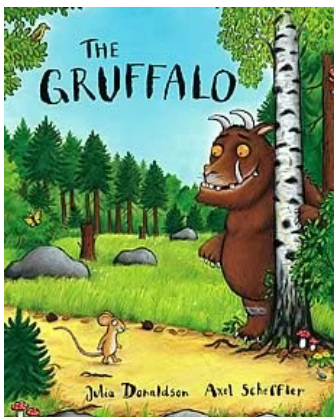

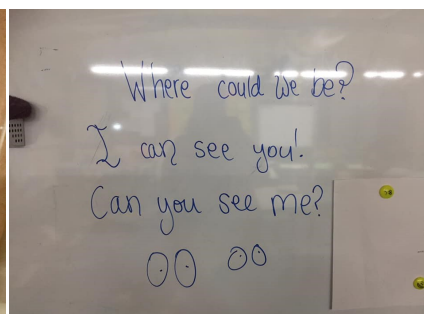
### Meet Our Mate 'Murray'
