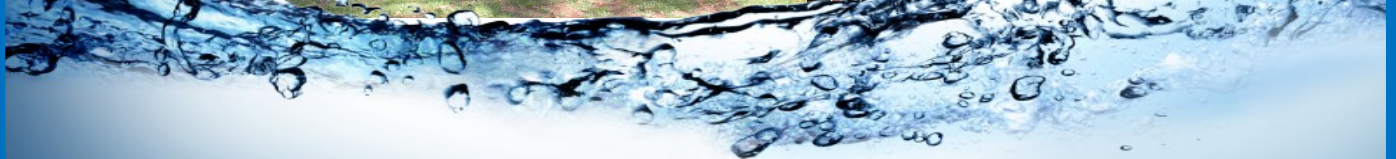

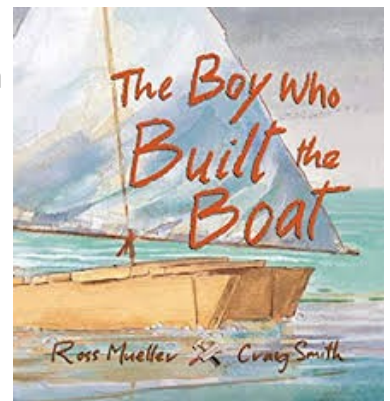

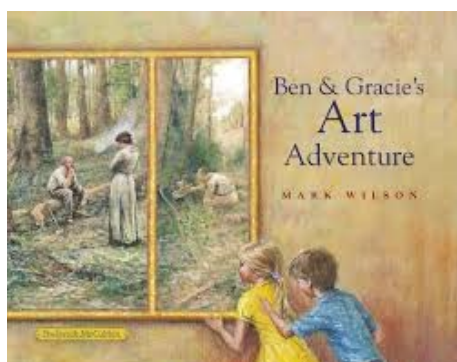
“The boy who built the boat” written by Ross Mueller and Craig Smith.

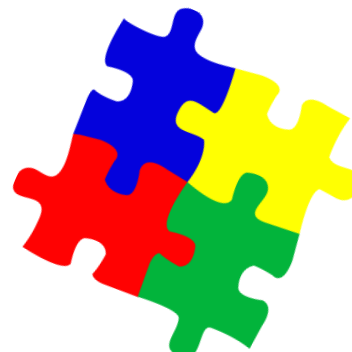

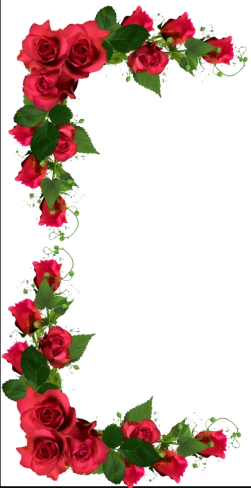
