A new computer desk has been installed in the staff room as well.

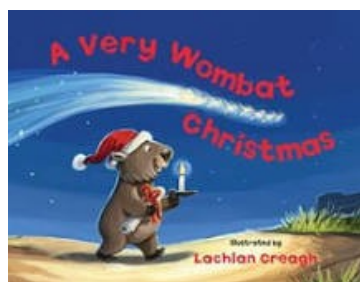
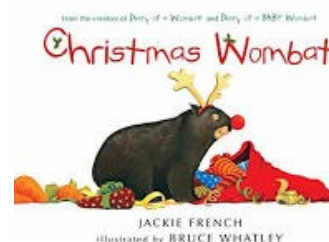
