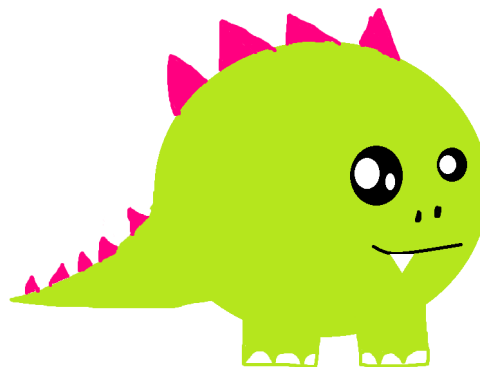
### JOKE OF THE WEEK
