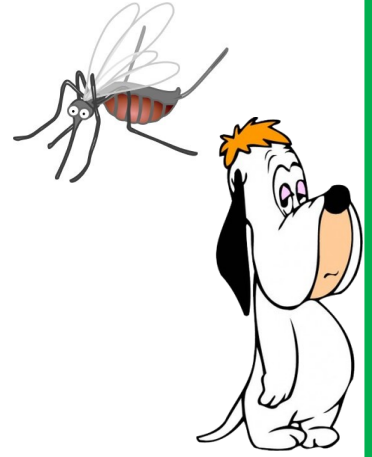

## JOKE OF THE WEEK

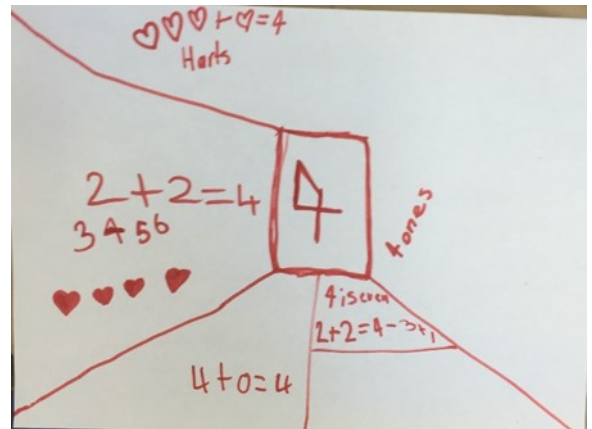
As part of the English study of humour, students from the secondary classes will be offering a joke of the week for the rest of this term.

R: A bloodhound!



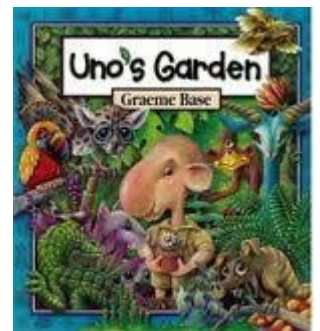
The primary school classes have been focusing on what a picture of a number look like. So, each week we will put a number up on our facebook page and we would like the community to post what they think or know about that number.
