Congratulations to the Gladiators that went this year.

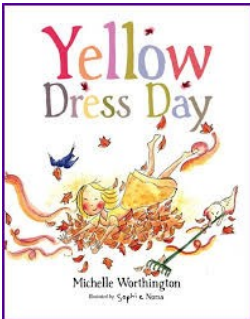


HUB

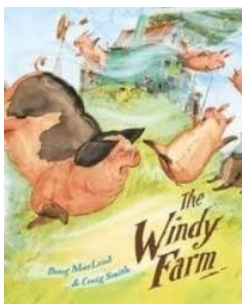
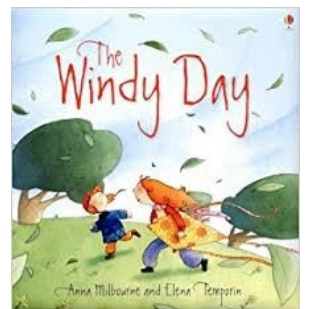


LIBRARY
