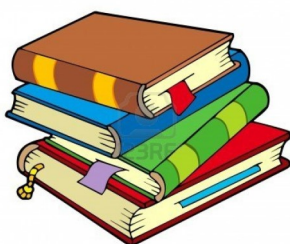

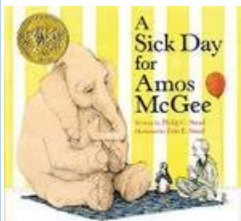

Amos McGee, the friendly zookeeper, always makes time to visit his good friends, the elephant, the tortoise, the penguin, the rhinoceros and the owl.

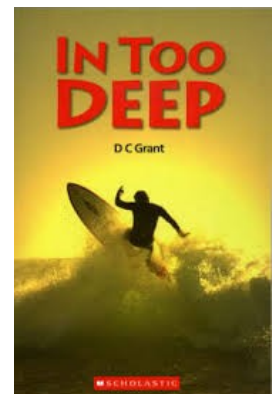
But one day—A-choo!! - he wakes up with the sniffles and sneezes. He doesn't make it to the zoo that day, but he does receive some unexpected guests....

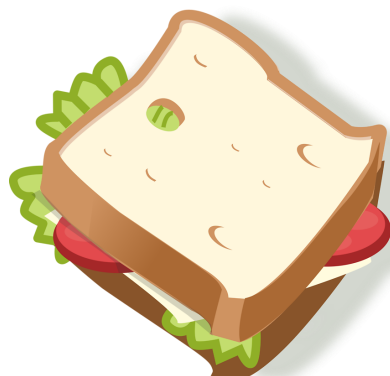
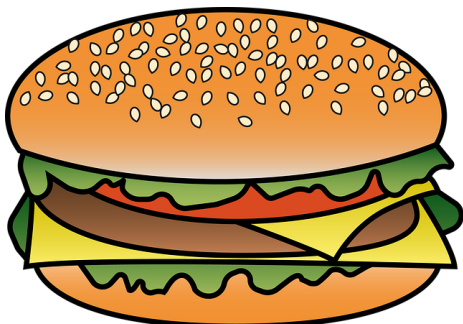

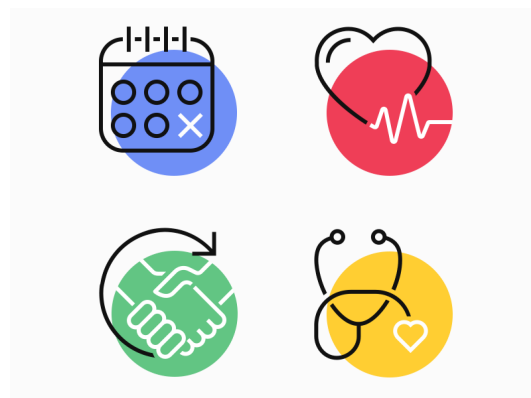
