I also had the opportunity to speak with Mark Scott (Secretary of Education) and addressed my concerns in relation to our school, specifically around staffing.





Special notes about the Estuary Cod.


There are over thirty species of fishes in Australia that are related to the estuary cod, but none grow as big.

Large adults of this species are hunted and killed by people because some think that this fish is dangerous. No attack on a person by an estuary cod is known to have occurred in Australia


This week we feature the following books:

'The Fisherman and the Theefyspray' written by Jane Tanner


